10. Format of Play		Stroke play tournament over four rounds of 18 holes with cut after 36 holes to leading 60 professionals plus ties.			
		In case of severe weather or other force majeure affecting fairness, the Tournament Committee will decide. A minimum of 36 holes must be completed for the event to be if shortened.			
		If there is a tie for first place, a sudden-death playoff will determine the champion. The playoff holes will be decided by the Committee and played hole-by-hole until a winner is determined.			
		Note: In the event of a tie among professional players for first place, a sudden-death playoff will also be held. The winner receives the trophy, while prize money is awarded to the topranking professional.			
		Prize money for tied professional players will be equally split based on the combined value of the tied positions.			
		For ties in other professional rankings, the tiebreaker will follow:			
		Better final round total score			
		If still tied, hole-by-hole comparison starting from the 18th hole moving backward. The tournament follows the latest R&A Rules of Golf.			
		Local rules and designated tee boxes are determined and announced by the Tournament			
		Committee.			
		All decisions made by the Tournament Committee are final.

		Players can't practice the second ball if hit on the green.			
		Players who like to practice on 7th May must book via <u>Google Form</u> and pay the green fee to TPGA. Tee times run from 6:30–7:30 AM every 6 minutes; all must finish by 11:00 AM.			
		Advance reservation is required for all practice rounds (except Pro-Am); without it, the course may deny entry. Double tee starts apply—strict adherence to booking rules is mandatory.

10% of the total prize money, will be allocated to the TPGA Tournament Development Fund.

Prize money will be awarded to the top 60 professional players based on their rankings.

After 2 rounds, if more than 60 players qualify for the next round, the tournament will announce the distribution of prize money for those ranked 61st and beyond. If there are too many players with the same score, the total amount cannot exceed the remaining prize money of NT\$81,000, which will be evenly distributed among those tied. In the event of a tie for any position other than first place, the prize money for each tied position will be divided equally among the players involved.

Prize money is subject to taxation according to the government, with a 10% deduction for players from Taiwan and a 20% deduction for players from other countries.
