Participants

Maximum number of players: 144

Eligibility:

1. Top 50 players in the 2024 Taiwan Tour Prize Money Ranking.
(Note: If a player withdraws, the organizer may nominate a replacement.)
2. 74 players selected by the Asian Development Tour.
3. 18 players invited by the Organizer (TPGA & Hsin Feng GC).
4. 2 players invited by ADT.

5. Players who did not attend the 2025 Taiwan PGA QT but are invited by the organizer/co-organizer will not have their annual ranking.
6. All of the above is in accordance with the 1st Extraordinary Board Meeting, 2024.

Entry Fee

1. NT\$1,650 for TPGA professional players.
2. NT\$2,500 for non-TPGA professionals.

Registration

All players must complete registration by 17:00 PM (+8GMT) on Friday, 25 April, 2025.

Withdrawal Policy

Before Fri, 2 May 2025 17:00 (+8GMT)

Players who withdraw must notify the organizer through LINE and submit supporting documents (e.g., medical certificate or receipt).

Players withdrawing after the final withdrawal deadline must still pay the entry fee unless in the case of major emergencies.

No withdrawal is allowed after making the cut or during the award ceremony, unless a special exemption is approved.

Practice & Facilities

Driving Range Fee: NT\$30 for 30 balls per box. Only one box per session is allowed and must be purchased on-site.

Free Balls During Tournament: One box of balls will be provided free of charge for each round (Rounds 1–4).

Available from one hour before tee time, between 5:30 AM and 3:00 PM.

The last ball issuance will be at 3:00 PM.

Practice Greens:

Putting green is located in front of the clubhouse pond.

Chipping area is behind the green of Hole 9 on the West Course.

Club Restrictions:

Woods are prohibited.

Only irons for distances under 200 yards may be used.

Practice must be done using plastic mats.

Caddies & Bag Policy

Caddies are one-on-one.

Players may bring their own caddies or use club caddies. However, the number of club caddies is limited. In the event of a shortage, less experienced caddies may be assigned for support.

Each player must pay an additional NT\$500 to club caddie after the playoff.

Attire & Conduct

Players may wear shorts during the tournament rounds.

Shorts are not allowed during official Pro-Am dinners.

Proper attire and hygiene are required for spectators.

Spectators are not allowed to ride in golf carts.

Equipment

Distance measuring devices are allowed as long as the slope function is disabled.

Green Fee

- During tournament rounds (4 rounds), players must pay NTD 2,355 in cash after submitting scorecards at the front desk. Receipts or tax IDs will be issued.
- If grouped players after the cut do not use club caddies, players must walk the course without a cart.
- For players using their own caddie: NT\$440 with cart, NT\$40 for walking only.
- During the official rounds, all players must use personal caddies (same charges as above).

Practice Days

Practice Before Tournament Week:

- Fees follow club policy. Show TPGA membership card for a discount.

Official Practice Days: May 26–27, 2025 (Mon–Tue)

- Full day access. No re-entry after 3 PM; reserve early.
- Using club caddies: NT\$2,355 (1 caddie for 3–4 players).
- Own caddie walking: NT\$40 insurance. Own caddie using cart: +NT\$440.
- Pay all fees at the front desk.
- Tee times must be reserved; double tee format enforced.
- Observe all course etiquette. Do not hit multiple balls on greens/fairways.

Registration

All players must complete registration by 3:00 PM on May 27 (Tue), 2025 at the tournament office (2F, clubhouse).

- Bring entry fee and green fees (2 rounds) in cash and exact change.
- Players with symptoms (flu, COVID-19) must wear masks.

Yardage Book

Available for sale at the venue.

- USD 30 or TWD 1,000 per book (subject to availability).
- Rangefinders allowed, slope function must be disabled.

Leave of Absence Policy

Only requests submitted on May 26 (Mon), 2025 or later will be accepted with proof (medical receipts, certificates, etc.).

- After final withdrawal deadline: must repay entry fee unless emergency exemption granted.
- During the event: submit withdrawal form and medical certificate.
- No leave accepted after making the cut or during the award ceremony, unless approved.

Physiotherapist Services

Free Physiotherapist service will be available during the tournament.

Location: Male locker Room, clubhouse 1F (subject to schedule posted).

Spectator Guidelines

Spectators allowed all 4 rounds. Must register at pro shop to receive badge.

- Insurance fee: NT\$20. Must wear proper shoes/clothing.
- Children under 6 and pets are not allowed.
- Spectators cannot ride on golf carts or interfere with play.

Locker Room

No deposit required. Use assigned lockers.

- Lost locker card will incur NT\$2,000 replacement fee.

Other Information

In the event of weather delays that prevent the completion of a round, the unfinished holes will be made up the next day. Players must voluntarily tip the caddies for the additional work.

Players must maintain the course in good condition throughout the tournament. Do not cause any damage.

Players carrying their own bags must place them in the designated open area near the 1st tee ground. Placing bags in the lobby is strictly prohibited.

Prize money will be transferred to players' accounts within 14 working days after the tournament concludes (excluding weekends and public holidays).

Wearing shorts is allowed during practice days, official practice days, and all four tournament rounds.

Proper dress etiquette is required throughout the tournament, including at press conferences, pro-am events, and luncheons/dinners. Players must adhere to the respective dress codes of each event. Wearing round-neck shirts, shorts, or slippers in the golf club is strictly prohibited, and violations will be referred to the disciplinary committee.

Prize money will be awarded to the top 50 professional players based on their rankings.

The prize money will be awarded to the top 50 professional players based on their rankings. If more than 50 players make the cut after the second round, the tournament committee will announce the prize distribution for those ranked 51st and beyond. In the event of ties, if there are too many players with the same score, the total prize allocated for those positions shall not exceed the remaining amount listed in the prize distribution table and will be evenly divided among the tied players.

Prize money is subject to taxation according to the government, with a 10% deduction for players from Taiwan and a 20% deduction for players from other countries.
